WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Anyone interested in officiating USA Swimming meets or who would like to learn about USA Swimming rules and regulations. Officiating is a way to help support your children's activity. Officiating is voluntary and offers the best seat in the house.

WHAT'S INVOLVED? Attend a clinic and take the USA Swimming officials test (open book) once every three years; work at meets and have fun with a great group of parents who are already officiating.

DIRECTIONS TO THE NATATORIUM:

1. Follow Route 7 toward Middlebury, VT
 2. Go through downtown Middlebury onto Route 30 South.
 3. Continue on Route 30 for almost a mile.
 4. The Athletic complex is on the left (east) side of Route 30.
- The Natatorium is about 50-55 minutes south of Burlington -
